## **Mini-Grant Application 2024**

One of the primary outcomes of The Career Pathway (CP) initiative is to engage institutions, organizations and community partners to address the challenges of recruitment for and retention of the early childhood care and education (ECCE) workforce and to build awareness of and support for Kansas' workforce. **Deadline for submissions:** All submissions must be submitted electronically here by EOD on February 23, 2024.

**Eligibility:** Proposals may be submitted by institutions of higher education, school districts including Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs, as well as municipalities, extension, employers, and community organizations across Kansas. The CP team will offer support and guidance throughout the application process including approved funding allocations. Funding may not be used to purchase food. Projects must be implemented in Kansas.
