

Workforce Study

The Kansas Comprehensive Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) Workforce Study was designed to provide a comprehensive understanding of the current state of the ECCE workforce in Kansas, because *Your Voice Counts*. The Office of Educational Innovation and Evaluation (OEIE) collaborated with the Kansas Early Childhood Career Pathway implementation team from Kansas Child Care Training Opportunities (KCCTO) to carry out this 2 part study.

- 1. Sent out 53,320 invitations to participate in the survey. We are thrilled to report that **5,623** of you completed the survey. Collectively, you represent every county in Kansas. Your responses have provided a wealth of information that will inform our efforts to improve the system.
- 2. Conducted 39 focus groups with a total of 324 participants. These sessions offered a deeper dive into your experiences and perspectives, enriching our understanding of the challenges and opportunities within the ECCE workforce.
